Boarding Parents' Committee

One of key collaboration mechanisms at Mount Erin Boarding is the Boarding Parents' Committee which consists of at least the following members:

- Co-Chairs from each College (to be members of each College Council)
- liaison parent/carer for each Year group, and where possible;
- liaison parent/carer for Indigenous boarders; and
- liaison parent/carer for boarders with disabilities.

The functions of the Boarding Parents' Committee include:

- promoting and supporting parent/family engagement with the Boarding School;
- attending the Boarding Parents' Committee Meetings (see below); and
- meeting with and making recommendations to Boarding School leadership in relation to Boarding School policy development and decision-making.

Mount Erin hosts Boarding Parents' Meetings each term. The aim of these regular meetings is to support the Leader of Boarding and Boarding Staff in their work. This also provides a forum for feedback, suggestions or inquiries from parents/carers on matters that they would like to discuss with regards to any aspect of boarding.
